

NPLATE® PREPARATION MAT

You must be trained by your healthcare provider before you can administer Nplate®.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Read all instructions for use thoroughly.
- You should establish a regular treatment schedule, even when travelling.
- Make sure you have all the supplies that you will need (refer to the images below).
- Check the expiration dates on all vials.
- Do not use if expired or left at room temperature for more than 30 days.
- Wash your hands with soap.
- Use an alcohol swab to clean the surface where you will be preparing product.

REPORTING OF SIDE EFFECTS:

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. Side effects can be reported directly to the Health Products Regulatory Authority (HPRA) using the available methods via www.hpra.ie.

By reporting side effects you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

NOTE:

Please use this mat along with the *Step-by-step guide* and/or *Package leaflet* and *Self-administration DVD* to prepare your Nplate® injection. You may be required to use more than one injection of Nplate®. If your doctor has instructed you to take more than one injection of Nplate®, follow the steps as defined in the *Step-by-step guide* to complete your prescribed dose of product using a new self-administration kit(s).

Make sure you have the following materials before you begin

A Product vial (1)



B1 Plunger rod (1)



B2 Prefilled sterile water syringe (1)



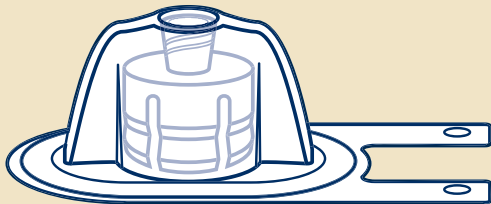
C Disposable 1 ml syringe with Luer lock (1)



D Safety needle: 27 G*, 13 mm (1)



E Vial adapter (1)



F Alcohol swab packages (x4)



G Sharps container (1; not supplied)



Store product vials in their carton to protect from light until use. This medicine may be removed from the refrigerator for a maximum period of 30 days at room temperature (up to 25°C). Your healthcare provider may recommend a different needle for injection.
